We are looking for passionate, eco-minded individuals to serve on the following committees:

Farmers Market Committee:

The Galloway Green Market serves to unite the community, featuring local farmers, florists/gardeners, bakers, beekeepers, cottage industries, area businesses and non-profits. It also offers live music, environmental education, and a “Buy Nothing” section where everything is FREE! This committee helps to further its development during the off-season and facilitate its operation during the in-season.

Forestry Stewardship Committee:

Trees are an invaluable asset to any community. Our State-approved Community Forestry Management Plan (CFMP) outlines goals and practices important to conserving our local tree canopy, and this committee assists with those - including tree inventorying, education and advocacy, and the development of our new CFMP in 2027.

“Friends Along the Mullica” Committee:

This committee assists with the outreach and activities outlined in the “Friends Along the Mullica” Sustainable Jersey Hub Grant. Galloway, in partnership with seven other towns along the Mullica River, is educating community members about climate change, wetlands loss, storm water issues, invasive species plants, wildlife management and habitat, litter, illegal dumping and damage from off-road vehicles.

“Friends of the Glenn” Committee:

This committee assists with the outreach and activities related to our Glenn by the Bay/Veterans Park property, where the focus is strong on native vs. invasive plants, local wildlife, wildlife habitat, education, etc.

Green Fair Planning Committee:

This popular annual eco-fair features many local farmers, gardeners, artisans, and sustainable vendors/organizations. This committee assists in choosing the yearly theme and attractions, coordinating new and prior vendors, and volunteering the day of the event.

Green Roof Committee:

This committee assists with the outreach and activities outlined in the “Green Roof” Sustainable Jersey Grant – including the maintenance and community education of this planted living roofline.

Organic Community Garden Committee:

This committee works to plant/weed/harvest and maintain 2/3 of our Organic Community Garden – the other 1/3 is rented by residents. It also educates the community about organic gardening methods (including pest control), composting, pollinators and rain barrels. Harvested produce is then donated to the Galloway Township Senior Center.

Patriot Lake Committee:

Patriot Lake is one of the most visited parks in Galloway Township. A former retention pond turned wildlife habitat and recreation area, this living memorial to the 9/11 attacks is a source of great community pride. The Patriot Lake Committee is responsible for weeding, pruning, planting trees and native plants, light maintenance and litter abatement when necessary.

Peaceful Pickers Committee:

In addition to participating in the annual “Earth Day in Galloway” and “Make a Difference Day in Galloway” town-wide cleanups, this committee goes out throughout the year and cleans up litter “hot spots” and areas of illegal dumping around the Township. As they do, they discuss various environmental “hot topics.”

“Pick Your Own” Committee:

Are you passionate about something environmental? Do you have a suggestion for a new committee? Propose it to the team and become a Project Lead! We are always open to new volunteers and fresh ideas. The ability to recruit new green team volunteers is also very helpful.

Seed Share Committee:

This committee collects native flower/plant and heirloom/vegetable seeds for free distribution to the public. Currently, they host a once a year “Seed Share” in October, but seed education happens throughout the year at various community events.

Zero Waste Committee:

This committee lives a “zero waste” lifestyle, practicing the “4 R’s” – Refuse.Reduce.Reuse.Recycle – and helping others to do the same.
