### **NEW APPLICATION**

7-18 Joseph DiGuglielmo 254 W. Terry Lane B. 559, L. 11 Zone VR

Mr. Joseph DiGuglielmo and Mr. Bill McManus PLS, PP were both sworn in.

The applicant is proposing to construct a garage with a rear yard setback variance of 10 feet where 15 feet is required. The proposed garage will be 720 sq feet and used for his classic car and motorcycle. There is also an existing 235 sq foot shed on the property that requires a rear and side yard variance.

Mr. McManus spoke about the positive and negative criteria of the application.

Tiffany Morrissey commented regarding the application.

Mr. Schroeder clarified there this will not be used for commercial use and there cannot be piles of car parts stored outside. Mr. DiGuglielmo stated he understands.
